Job Title: Community Recreation Therapist
Reports To: Executive Officers
FLSA Status: Full-Time (40 hours per week)

Core Unique Position Responsibilities:

- To facilitate community-integrated therapeutic and outcome-based activities for individuals with developmental disabilities (DD). This position is responsible for improving Individuals' physical and emotional well-being by developing and implementing person-centered services that will enable people to integrate into their community via group activities, volunteering and more.
- To assess individuals needs, the recreational therapist will consider Individual Service Plans (ISPs), personal observation and discussions with the individual and their support network. The therapist will then execute a therapeutic program targeted toward what that individual requires most. Therapists will document and show an individuals' progress during their activities.
- Safely operate CLI-owned passenger vehicles and provide necessary assistance to enable individuals to access community and program resources..
- Work cooperatively with other CLI staff to further agency goals and increase overall opportunities for integration and meaningful natural supports for people with developmental disabilities.
